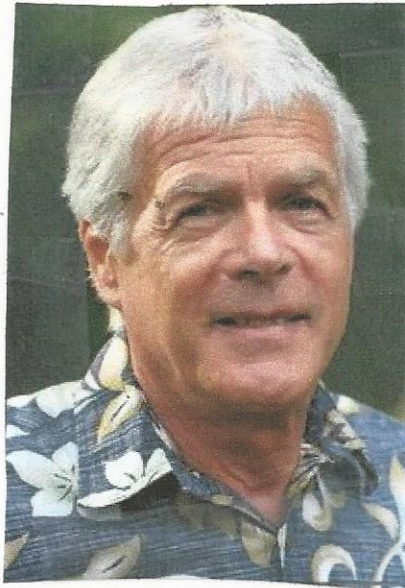

PETER F. SALE CHANGES TO THE CORAL REEFS

"HUMANITY IN THE ANTHROPOCENE-PLANETARY DAMAGE AND BIOSPHERE REPAIR"



PETER SALE IS AN ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENTIST WHOSE RESEARCH INTO ECOLOGY OF CORAL REEFS SPANNED A CAREER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SYDNEY (1968-87), UNIVERSITY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE (1988-93), UNIVERSITY OF WINDSOR (1994-2006) AND MOST RECENTLY UNITED NATIONS UNIVERSITY'S INSTITUTE FOR WATER, ENVIRONMENT AND HEALTH (2007-14). HE REMAINS DISTINGUISHED UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR (EMERITUS) AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WINDSOR. EDUCATED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO AND THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, HE NOW LIVES WITH HIS WIFE DONNA IN MUSKOKA, CONTUING TO WRITE AND SPEAK ON CRIITICAL ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES.

HIS RECENT BOOK, "OUR DYING PLANET" TELLS THE STORY OF OUR IMPACTS ON THE ENVIRONMENT FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF AN ECOLOGIST WHO HAS SEEN ENVIRONMENTAL DECLINE WITH HIS OWN EYES.

HE BRINGS HIS EXPERTISE IN ACQUATIC ECOLOGY TO THE DELIBERATIONS OF THE MUSKOKA WATERSHED COUNCIL.
