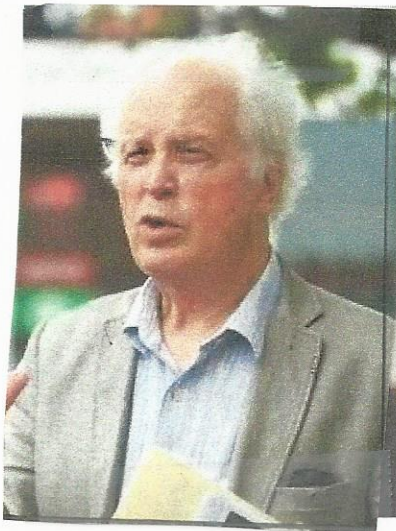

**ELWOOD JONES. Ph D .PROFESSOR EMERITUS (HISTORY) TRENT
UNIVERSITY**



Elwood Jones, an historian and archivist from Peterborough has written about 15 books on the local area including last year's "Finding Champlains Dream". Champlain passed through the Kawarths 400 years ago. This was the first European presence in this area, but more than that it was the signature expedition of Champlain's career. Interestingly Champlain's expedition was driven by First Nations' objectives. This talk will look at some of the implications of Champlain's expedition and discuss what we learn about the Kawarths then. As well, it will look at the impact on European, First Nations and French ambitions in this region.

Elwood Jones is the archivist at Trent Valley Archives, editor of the Heritage Gazette of the Trent Valley, and also the lead Saturday columnist for the Peterborough Examiner since 2007.
