She discussed the importance of the poppy as a sign of remembrance, the daily Last Post service at the Menin Gate in Ypres, Belgium and the importance of the Battle at Vimy Ridge to the birth of our nation. She also spoke about Dieppe, Juno Beach and some of the atrocities that occurred during WWII. During her

presentation, we enjoyed her songs of remembrance. accompanied by her guitar.

There were tears of sadness in the eyes of some of our members at the conclusion of the presentation. She received a standing ovation from the group.
