About John Boyko:



John Boyko is an author and historian whom *The Globe and Mail* deemed, “a distinguished scholar of Canadian political history” with the *Winnipeg Free Press* praising his, “encyclopaedic knowledge of Canadian history.”

Boyko is the best-selling author of seven books addressing Canadian history and politics including *Sir John's Echo: The Voice for a Stronger Canada*, *Cold Fire: Kennedy's Northern Front*, and *Blood and Daring: How Canada Fought the American Civil War and Forged a Nation*.

John Boyko is also an op. ed. contributor to *The Globe and Mail*, *Calgary Herald*, *Ottawa Citizen*, *Montreal Gazette*, *Maclean's*, and more. He contributes entries to the Canadian Encyclopedia. John is also a respected speaker having addressed audiences across the country while appearing on radio and television discussing his books and various political and historical issues.

Boyko has earned degrees from Trent, Queen's, and McMaster Universities, served on and chaired many boards and has been elected to municipal office and served at the local and county levels. The former Dean of History, is now an administrator at Lakefield College School. John lives in the Village of Lakefield.
